Assistance League® of Flintridge Drama Committee is planning a program for Fall 2020. The committee wishes your input. The program, under the leadership of Katelyn Fike and Tristan Waldron, will run 8 weeks beginning the 2nd month of the La Cañada Unified School District year. There will be 16-20 one-hour drama workshops delivered live, virtually at designated times on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 5th-10th graders. The virtual platform allows for other approaches in the ALF Drama Program.

Topics under consideration include:

Performances of skits and scenes with a partner or with a small group

Character Development

Monologues

Improviseational Games

Auditioning in front of a camera for a commercial or a role on TV

Musical Numbers with song and dance with Nancy Abbott at the piano

Utilizing Zoom tools: Backgrounds and a variety of recordings

Each student will receive a T-shirt and a recording of the performances.

The estimated cost per student is \$125.00 for 16-20 workshops.
