

ALF PROTOCOL FOR COVID-19

Whenever coming onto the ALF premises (ALF members, employees, community volunteers) everyone is asked to sign in, answer 3 questions and take their temperature.

There are signs up at the Chapter House, and more signs will go up to remind those entering the premises.

There is a blue notebook on the credenza in the Members' Hallway. Inside are instructions and the sign in sheets. The thermometer is also there, attached by a string or ribbon to the notebook, so it does not disappear.

These are the questions:

- 1. Are you currently experiencing, or experienced in the last 14 days, fever or chills or any other symptoms associated with COVID-19 (see list on wall if not sure)?**
- 2. Are you caring for or come in contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or experiencing symptoms associated with COVID-19 within the past 14 days (see list on wall if not sure)?**
- 3. Have you traveled outside of California or internationally (or been in contact with someone who has) in the last 14 days?**
- 4. Please take your temperature and record on chart – if temperature is above 100.4 degrees, please advise Manager that you cannot staff.**
