COVID-19 Protocols

Assistance League® of Flintridge Summer School is committed to a summer program that is safe and enjoyable for all students, staff and volunteers. In coordination with the La Cañada Unified School District and following Los Angeles County Health guidelines, we have established the following health protocols:

- Families will answer basic COVID-19 questions daily by displaying a COVID-19 Questions Placard in the passenger-side windshield area of their vehicle. Walking students must show the placard or be prepared to answer the questions verbally.
- Upon arrival to school, students will have their temperatures taken and will use hand sanitizer as they enter the playground.
- Masks will be required for all students, teachers, staff and volunteers.
- Students will remain with their color groups of 15-16 students both in the classroom and on the playground.
- Every classroom has its own restroom that will be routinely sanitized.
- Each student will be given their own bag of supplies for classroom use (ie. scissors, crayons, etc.)
- Parents and visitors, other than vaccinated ALF members (volunteers), will not be allowed on campus.
- Any student with symptoms of COVID-19, MUST notify the school office and stay at home.
- If a potential positive case of COVID-19 in a student is identified, the family will be informed about testing and must quarantine at home until the results are received. The family may be interviewed for “contract tracing” purposes.
- For students who share the same color group with a student who has been identified as a potential positive case, the families will be notified immediately and given instructions for further action.

We are hopeful that everyone involved with ALF Summer School this year, will be taking precautions and that we will get through the 4-week program with no cases! We look forward to seeing you in person!
