Assisteens & Families,

The Assisteens had their first “Meet and Greet” meeting on Tuesday, August 23. Surprisingly, quite a few members did not attend and only one informed us of the absence ahead of time. We know you may have conflicts during the school year but since Assisteens is only once a month, it is expected you will attend and will let us know if you cannot.

Assisteens only source of philanthropic income is revenue from staffing the Bargain Box, our thrift store. This year, Assisteens have the opportunity to assist our organization EVERY Saturday of the month, September through April.

The 1st Saturday of the month we can use 10 teens to cull the older merchandise and prepare it for another non-profit to receive. The shift would be 10:00 a.m. until noon. We had only 3 students sign up for September 3rd: JP, RS, and GM.

The 2nd Saturday of the month is our regular staffing responsibility. We price, replenish, operate cash registers, clean dressing rooms, and sort incoming donations. The shift is 9:30 a.m. until around 1:15 p.m. We can use a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10. We will also help get merchandise ready for the upcoming Halloween Sale that day. Only 1 student signed up for September 10th: KB.

The 3rd and 4th Saturdays of the month, we can use 4-6 teens to only work in the pricing room, accepting and processing donations. The shift is 10:00 a.m until 1:00 p.m. No one signed up for September 17 or 24.

Remember this is a service organization and everyone is expected to participate. Besides, it’s fun! There will be opportunities at every Regular meeting to sign up for Bargain Box shifts and committee work. Please come prepared with possible dates that you can help out. You may also give us dates now via email for shifts in September. We would love to add your name.
