The *SPROUTS* program has a unique position available for those interested in working with preschool-aged students with special needs in an after-school program (elementary school setting).

SPROUTS is an early intervention enrichment program benefitting young children, preschool through the start of kindergarten, with developmental delays. The program is language-based, meeting twice a week (3:30-4:30 pm). Activities address gross and fine motor skills, floor play, cooperative play and other activities. In addition to the the *SPROUTS* Teacher, a Speech/Language Pathologist is part of the team. Parents and primary caregivers are encouraged to participate with their child by attending sessions.

- * Organizes and implements an integrated, language-based learning environment for children ages three to five, not attending kindergarten
- * Holds a teaching credential in multiple subjects and Early Childhood Development and Special Education
- * Has experience teaching early childhood Special Education
