Date: July 2022

Position: Teacher

Location: Paradise Canyon Elementary School

Time Commitment: Conduct sessions twice a week for one hour each during the school year

(Currently Monday and Wednesday, 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.)

Position Description: Organize and implement an integrated, language-based learning environment for children ages three to five, not attending kindergarten.

Qualifications:

- 1. Teaching credential in multiple subjects including Early Childhood Development, Special Education, Learning Handicapped and Severely Handicapped
- 2. Experience teaching early childhood Special Education
- 3. Ability to communicate effectively (both verbally and in written reports) within a multidisciplinary team
- 4. Ability to organize, coordinate and conduct parent meetings, Individual Education Plan (IEP) meetings, and interdisciplinary team meetings, writing goals and objectives as needed
- 5. Ability to provide support services to students, teachers, and families involved in inclusive programs
- 6. Member of an early childhood professional organization
- 7. Knowledge of current special education laws pertaining to early childhood intervention program and services
- 8. Ability to use a computer for *SPROUTS* program needs
- 9. Health and stamina to work effectively with young children with various special needs
- 10. Current health immunizations
- 11. Trained in basic first aid and CPR for young children

Responsibilities

- 1. Communicate and consult with pre-schools, staff members, therapists, and families
- 2. Actively train and coordinate training for aides (volunteers, student teachers and interns) within the *SPROUTS* program
- 3. Communicate on a regular basis with Assistance League (CAP) SPROUTS Chairman and parents
- 4. As a representative of the *SPROUTS* Program speak publicly to the LCUSD School Board, Cañada Auxiliary of Professionals (CAP) and Assistance League of Flintridge (ALF) meetings and upon request to community, school and other professional meetings
- 5. Maintain appropriate records
- 6. Research appropriate equipment and strategies with the team to meet student's individual challenges and learning style
