**Sectionals** for Brass, Woodwind and String students will all be held in the Chapter Meeting Room (CMR) behind the Assistance League Chapter House, 4607 Oakwood Avenue in La Cañada Flintridge. Your students should bring their instrument, music folder, and a pencil.

**Concerts:** Dress for the students will be black pants or skirt and ALF Music T-Shirt with black dress shoes, if possible. Concerts shouldn't be more than an hour and a half.

**Concert Solos:** The instructors have been talking to the advanced students about the opportunity to audition for a concert solo. If your child is interested, see the attached solo request form and details. Although we would love for every student to have a solo, due to time constraints, we need to limit the number of solo performances. We also want the solos to be a positive experience for the students so please understand if your student is not chosen for one. Feel free to contact your student's instructor if you have any questions or concerns regarding solos.

**Classes:** Regular morning classes will continue during Concert week 5/6-5/9; however, there will not be any afternoon classes that week due to rehearsals/concerts. Each class will have one final regular class time for the year after their respective concerts. Please send your child to this wrap-up class so that the instructors can discuss the concert, collect rental instruments, and encourage the students to continue to play over the summer and to continue on next year.

**Summer School:** ALF Summer School offers instrumental music classes. Summer School registration will open on 3/11.
