

STUDENT CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBILITY GUIDELINES

Please read all of the information provided regarding student conduct and responsibility.

RULES

1. Students should treat the school like it is their own home.
2. Students must walk in the hallways and sidewalks.
3. Students are responsible for putting their trash into trash containers on the playground.
4. Gum is not permitted.
5. Students should not take things that are not theirs or given to them without permission. They should not damage anything.
6. Personal student items of play (game equipment, trading cards, toys, etc.) may not be brought to school, unless specific permission is given by the teacher and Principal. This includes IPODS and other electronic games.
7. Cell phones and electronic devices may only be used before school or after school. Phones and electronic items used during class, unless instructed by the teacher, will result in confiscation and return to the student's parent or guardian.
8. No items are to be thrown (rocks, sticks, pine cones, paper wads, etc.)
9. Settle differences peacefully -- Do not push, shove, hit, or hurt another person in any way. This includes threatening to hurt someone. Fighting, real or "play fighting" (karate, wrestling, etc.) is treated as serious and possible cause for suspension. No person is to be physically harmed by another.
10. Show respect to every student and every adult. Students may not tease, harass, malign or threaten. Do not use language that hurts another person's feelings, contains profanity, or provokes a fight.
11. If a mistake is made, students should strive to do better the next day.
12. Never leave the campus without permission. If leaving early, students must check out at the office.

DRESS CODE

All students need to follow a code of appropriate dress for a learning environment. Certain clothes are appropriate for the beach, for a party or for the gym but may not be appropriate for the classroom. Students must adhere to the following guidelines

- For safety concerns, tennis shoes are recommended; flip-flops, sandals are not advised.
- No logos, words, or symbols should be worn on clothing that is discriminatory, racist, sexist, and/or promotes violence, weapons, drugs, or alcohol.
- Shorts, dresses, and skirts should be of a modest length (no short shorts).
